Christ have mercy, Lord have mercy"</p>	<p>It is a song of Praise "Glory to God in the highest, and peace to His people on earth..."</p>	<p>It is a reading from the Old Testament, read by a lay person</p>	<p>It is a song/poem from the Old Testament - the people repeat the response in between the verses</p>
<p>It is a reading from the New Testament</p>	<p>It is a reading about Jesus' life or his teachings by the PRIEST</p>	<p>It is when the priest explains the readings (=the sermon)</p>	<p>It is a statement of Catholic beliefs "We believe in one God, the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth..."</p>
<p>It is when the congregation pray to God for people in need</p>	<p>The prayers by which the priest calls down the Holy Spirit to 1. accept the offering of bread and wine and 2. make it into Jesus' body and blood</p>	<p>It is when the gifts and wine are carried to the altar as a symbol the sacrifice of ourselves to God, and God's for us</p>	<p>It is a prayer that Jesus taught "Our Father, who art in heaven..."</p>
<p>It is when we shake hands with others as a sign we are at peace with them</p>	<p>It is when you receive the REAL PRESENCE (Jesus' body and blood under the form of bread and wine)</p>	<p>It is when the priest blesses you before we leave</p>	<p>It is when the priest dismisses the congregation saying "Go in peace, to love and serve the Lord"</p>
